If you can't get your book donation to the library, we can arrange a pickup at your convenience.

We are interested in many kinds of books, including:

- Hardcover and Paperback, Fiction and Nonfiction
- DVDs and Books on CD (must be operable, include original artwork and casing)
- Ex-library Copies (do not remove library treatments)
- Textbooks (copyright within last 10 years)
- Trade Paperbacks
- Travel Books (copyright within last 5 years)

Yes! We want to include your books in our sale if they are in good condition.

No! We do not accept *books* in the following condition:

- Dirty, Torn, Moldy, Mildewed or Warped
- Stained, Water damaged or Smoke damaged
- Damaged or Missing Covers, Binding or Pages
- Obscured Text, Excessive Writing, Markings, or Highlighting

Sorry, but we do not accept the following Books and Materials:

- Law Books, Tax or Government Documents
- Directories, Telephone Books, Encyclopedia
- Open Software Sets
- Reader's Digest Condensed
