

SECRETS OF the LIBRARY

Well, not really secrets, just things you may not know but might need.... For instance, everybody knows that the library has books, DVDs and CDs, but did you know there is a whole "Library of Things" that can be checked out or used in the library? There are board games, lawn games, beach equipment, fishing rods (complete with reel, line and a small tackle box), five (!) sewing machines, a telescope, Wi-Fi hotspots and passes to a variety of museums and parks. And more!

Love movies, but hate paying for streaming services? Your library card is your free ticket to streaming movies and documentaries using Kanopy. You'll find popular movies, classics and a stunning array of documentaries.

Access to eBooks and Audiobooks is a snap using Overdrive or the easy-peasy Libby app especially designed for users of smartphones, tablets and most eBook readers.

Speaking of books, did you know that in addition to being able to borrow from any island library and most of the Cape, you also have access to just about every library in the state through the Commonwealth Catalog? As if that isn't enough, if you have a really unusual request the library staff can scour the nation looking for a participating library system able to fill your request.

Have you always dreamed of learning a foreign language or improving your English skills? Tap into Mango, an online language program, or explore our ESL and English Conversation Circle programs. Find out where your family comes from via our free subscription to Ancestry, a family genealogy system available for use in the library.

Is your computer or cellphone giving you grief? Schedule an appointment or drop in during the Saturday morning tech help service or sign up for computer classes.

If an accident, illness, disability or a new infant makes it difficult to get to the library, the library can come to you. Books and library materials can be delivered to your door. Simply fill out an online application or call the library to get started. The library also has an accessible computer setup and assistive listening devices to make it possible for you to get the most out of the library programs.

Best of all, your books will automatically renew if there's no waitlist for it and the library has gone fine-free. So check us out. You'll be glad you did!
